CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That DONALD W. RANDALL

of Route 1, Box 411, Monroe, State of Oregon 97456, has
a right to the use of the waters of Reese Creek through the Bellfountain Ditch

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Benton County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 18, at page 367, that the priority of the right
thereby confirmed dates from 1850

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 4,000 gallons per
day.

The point of diversion is located on the NE $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ as projected within Orrin Belknap DLC 56,
Section 11, T14S, R6W, WM; 1640 feet South and 540 feet East from NW corner
Orrin Belknap DLC 56.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as
follows:


