CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

DANIEL LARRY JACKSON

of 5291 Riverbanks Road, Grants Pass, State of Oregon 97526, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of spring area and Shan Creek,

a tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of irrigation of 1.8 acres

under Permit No. 37661 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 6, 1973

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second from spring area when available with any deficiency in the available supply from spring area to be made up by appropriation from Shan Creek provided that the total quantity diverted from both sources *

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW 1/4 SW 1/4, NW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 11, T36S, R7W, WM; Spring - 1,350 feet South and 950 feet East, Creek - 1,060 feet South and 1,250 feet East both from W 1/4 Corner Section 11

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 1/2 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:


1.6 acres NW 1/4 SW 1/4
0.2 acre SW 1/4 SW 1/4
Section 11
Township 36 South, Range 7 West WM

*shall not exceed 0.02 cfs

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
