CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That MAYBELLA COMSTOCK

of 76457 Martin Creek Road, Cottage Grove, State of Oregon 97424, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of a spring and Martin Creek

a tributary of Coast Fork Willamette River for the purpose of domestic use for two families and irrigation of 0.5 acre

under Permit No. 41294 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the rights hereby confirmed dates from January 3, 1977

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.015 cubic foot per second, being 0.005 cfs from spring for domestic use and 0.01 cfs from creek for irrigation

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 24, T21S, R4W, WM; Spring - 1,025 feet South and 875 feet West; Creek - 470 feet South and 1,210 feet West, both from NE corner, Section 24.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.


A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

domestic and 0.5 acre NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 24
Township 21 South, Range 4 West, WM

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
