CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

(For rights perfected under reservoir permits)

This is to Certify, That THE SPRAGUE RIVER LAND AND LIVESTOCK COMPANY of Bly, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, of a right to store the waters of Fish Hole Creek and flood waters tributary to Fish Hole Creek and Devil's Lake, tributary of Devil's Lake

for the purposes of irrigation and domestic use

under Reservoir Permit No. 68 of the State Engineer, and that said right to store said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon and duly confirmed by order of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, made and entered of record in the Record of Proceedings of said Board, at Salem, in Volume 1, at page 160, on the 17th day of July, 1914; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from October 11, 1910

that the amount of water entitled to be stored each year under such right, for the purposes aforesaid, shall not exceed 850 acre feet.

The reservoir is located in Sections 32 and 33, Tp. 37 S., R. 15 E., W. N.
