CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That STAYTON CANNING COMPANY COOP

of 930 West Washington Street, Stayton, State of Oregon 97383, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Well 4

a tributary of Jones Ditch for the purpose of industrial use (cannery)

under Permit No. G-7902 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 13, 1977 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.1 cubic feet per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the well. The well is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Martel DLC 65, Section 8, T6S, R2W, WM 2,512 feet South 68° 34' East from the re-entrant corner on the West Line of the Augustus Lambert DLC 61

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

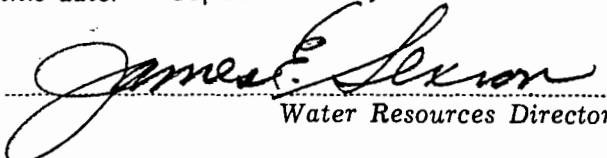
SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ as projected within Martel DLC 65
