CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That SAMUEL WIEHL

of Sisters, State of Oregon 97759, has
a right to the use of the waters of
Squaw Creek

a tributary of Deschutes River for the purpose of
irrigation of 21.0 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Crook County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 1, at page 120; that the priority of the right
thereby confirmed dates from
1900

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed
0.42 cubic foot per second.

The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 29, T15S, R10E, WM, Plainview-
Wiehl Ditch - 710 feet North and 2,640 feet West from SW Corner, Section 28.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as
follows:

21.0 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 28
Township 15 South, Range 10 East, WM


This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the
prior certificate recorded at page 310, Volume 1, State Record of Water Right
Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources
Director entered on June 29, 1981, approving Transfer Application 4784.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the
water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture
or abandonment.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein
described.
