## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

WILLIAM F.-FESSLER

of Route 1, Box 306A, Silverton , State of Oregon 97381 , has made proof to the satisfiction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Abiqua Creek

a tributary of Pudding River frrigation of 68.8 acres for the purpose of

under Permit No. 28850 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 27, 1963

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.86 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the  $NW_3$  SW4, as projected within Shepan's DLC 38, Section 28, T6S, R1E, WM; 1,830 feet South and 770 feet East from westerly NW Corner, Shepard DLC 38.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightiethof one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed  $2\frac{1}{2}$  acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
