CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That MARVIN E. and VIVIAN KRANICK and
E. W. and MABEL S. HUGHES

of Route 1, Box 670, Bandon, State of Oregon 97411, has made
proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of
Green Gulch and Conner Creek

a tributary of Four Mile Creek and Croft Creek for the purpose of
irrigation of 12.3 acres

under Permit No. 15439 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in
accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from
March 6, 1943

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes
aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed
0.63 cubic foot per second, being 0.45 cfs from Conner Creek and 0.18 cfs from
Green Gulch

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.
The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ -SE $\frac{1}{4}$, NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 12, T30S,
R15W, WM.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other
right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-tenth of one cubic foot per second
per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited
to a diversion of not to exceed 0.75 acre-foot for each acre irrigated in any
30-day period and shall be still further limited to a diversion of not to
exceed 6 acre-feet per acre during the irrigation season of each year if for
irrigation of cranberries; for any other crop irrigated, this appropriation
shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent
for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not
to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the * and shall
conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

is appurtenant, is as follows:



The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described. and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board
