CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

JAMES C. and MARION M. McBEE

of 88869 Evers Road, Elmira , State of Oregon 97437 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Abe's Creek and reservoir constructed under Permit R-6381

a tributary of Croft Lake for the purpose of irrigation of 0.80 acre, supplemental irrigation of 4.86 acres, and flood harvesting 5.66 acres under Permit No. 39820 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 25, 1974 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed

aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.28 cubic foot per second, being 0.14 cfs for irrigation and supplemental irrigation, and 0.28 cfs for harvesting cranberries

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE 174 SW 1/4, Section 11, T3OS, R15W, WM; 900 feet South and 2,670 feet West from E 1/4 Corner, Section 11

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, for cranberries, from direct flow and storage from the reservoir constructed under Permit R-6381. If for the irrigation of any other crop, this appropriation shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated * and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
