## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That** JOHN MCKEE

of Route 3, Box 1005, Roseburg, State of Oregon 97470, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Umpqua River

a tributary of Pacific Ocean for the purpose of irrigation of 76.8 acres

under Permit No. 29072 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 27, 1963

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.71 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected within Woodruff DLQ 38, Section 18, T26S, R6W, WM; 470 feet North and 6,210 feet East from SW Corner, Section 13, T26S, R7W, WM.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the right to use of water is limited to the period when the flow of the Umpqua River is more than 525 cfs at tidewater;

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

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0.2 acre SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  as projected within Woodruff DLC 60  
0.3 acre NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  as projected within Woodruff DLC 60  
25.8 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  as projected within Woodruff DLC 60  
16.2 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  as projected within Woodruff DLC 60  
1.2 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  as projected within Woodruff DLC 60

5.2 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  as projected within Woodruff DLC 38  
23.9 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  as projected within Woodruff DLC 38  
4.0 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  as projected within Woodruff DLC 38


