CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That ANDREW H., MARLINE, and ESTHER KOCH

of Box 61, Azalea, State of Oregon 97410, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Dismal Creek

a tributary of Cow Creek for the purpose of irrigation of 1.0 acre

under Permit No. 11033 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the rights hereby confirmed dates from September 18, 1933

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.015 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the creek

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 10, T32S, R3W, WM; 1,250 feet South and 390 feet East from W 1/4 Corner, Section 10

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-seventieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season from April 1 to October 1 of each year, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 1/2 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

1.0 acre NE 1/4 NW 1/4
Section 10
Township 32 South, Range 3 West, WM


This certificate is issued to confirm a change in place of use approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered November 17, 1976 and together with the Certificate of Water Right recorded at page 44166, Volume 36, State Record of Water Right Certificates, supersedes Certificate 11320.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
