## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That LAWRENCE and MARJORIE IVERSON

of Silver Lake , State of Oregon 97638 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Marjorie Iverson Well

a tributary of Silver Creek irrigation of 151.5 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. G-5739 and that suil right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 26, 1973

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.891 cubic feet per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the well. The well is located in the NE $_4$  NE $_4$ , Section 19, T28S, R15E, WM; 1,040 feet South and 1,250 feet West from NE Corner, Section 19.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

8.3 acres SW4 SE4 Section 18 31.5 acres SW4 NE4 28.7 acres SE4 NE4 Section 19

41.5 acres NE's NE's

Township 28 South, Range 15 East, WM

41.5 acres NW¼ NE¼

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded at page 46575, Volume 39, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on September 25, 1981, approving Transfer 4868.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
