CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That JOHN W. RAMAGE

of Route 2, Woodburn , State of Oregon 97071 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Pudding River

a tributary of Molalla River irrigation of 4.5 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 17191 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 8, 1946

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.056 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within John Sanders DLC, Section 10, T5S, R1W, WM.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightiethof one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

2.8 acres SW4 NE4 as projected within John Sanders DLC 1.7 acres SE4 NE4 as projected within John Sanders DLC Section 10 Township 5 South, Range 1 West, WM

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded at page 17061, Volume 14, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT canceled by the provisions of orders of the Water Resources Director entered on September 17, 1981 and October 30, 1981.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
