

CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

STATE-OF-OREGON, OREGON-STATE HOSPITAL

of Salem , State of Oregon 97310 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Rickreall Creek, Hayden Slough and Willamette River

a tributary of Columbia River irrigation of 219.3 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 15237 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 6. 1942

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 2.75 cubic feet per second; being 0.18 cfs from Rickreall Creek, 0.81 cfs from Hayden Slough, and 1.76 cfs from Willamette River,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW4 NE4, Section 35 (Rickreall Creek); SE4 SW4, Section 25, NW4 NW4, SW4 NW4, Section 36 (Hayden Slough), all as projected within J. Shaw DLC 60; Lot 6 (NE4 SW4), Lot 5 (SE4 SW4), Section 36 (Willamette River), T7S, R4W, WM.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightiethof one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described. and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board
