## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That** FRANK S. CHAPMAN

of 5387 McLaughlin Drive, Central Point, State of Oregon 97501, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of a well

a tributary of Whetstone Creek for the purpose of irrigation of 8.28 acres

under Permit No. G-5140 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 17, 1970 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.10 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the well. The well is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 32, T36S, R1W, WM; 690 feet South and 510 feet West from E $\frac{1}{4}$  corner, Section 32.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.


A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Section 32  
Township 36 South, Range 1 West, WM

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
