CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That ROMNEY ULLIAN

of 2705 Rogue River Highway, Gold Hill, State of Oregon 97525, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Rogue River

a tributary of Pacific Ocean for the purpose of temperature control for 6.5 acres

under Permit No. 36057 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the rights hereby confirmed dates from March 25, 1971

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.95 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 3 (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 11, T36S, R3W, WM; 1550 feet South and 2260 feet East from NW corner of Section 11.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.


A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.7 acre NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
5.8 acres SW $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
both as projected within William Miller DLC 43
Section 25
Township 36 South, Range 4 West, WM

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
