CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify,** That BECKER RANCH, INC.

of Box 776, Vale State of Oregon 97918, has  
a right to the use of the waters of South Fork Indian Creek

a tributary of Bully Creek for the purpose of  
irrigation of 145.4 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Malheur County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 8, at page 228; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1884;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one and one-half acre-feet per acre in any 30-day period prior to June 1, one acre-foot per acre in any 30-day period after June 1 of each year, or three acre-feet per acre during any season, diverted at a rate not to exceed one-twentieth of a cubic foot per second per acre

The point of diversion is located in the SE 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 18, T18S, R40E, WM; NW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 13, T18S, R39E, WM; 1,440 feet South and 1,550 feet East from NW Corner, Section 18, 2,480 feet North and 334 feet East from SW Corner, Section 13

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:


This certificate is issued to confirm an additional point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered May 9, 1979 and together with certificates of water right recorded at pages 50444, 50445, 50446, 50447, 50449 and 50450, Volume 44, State Record of Water Right Certificates, and orders of the Water Resources Director entered March 6, 1935 and April 14, 1980, supersedes certificate of water right recorded at page 6939, Volume 7, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

*And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.*
