## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

W. J. PULLEN

of Route 2, Box 230, Bandon ,State of Oregon 974ll ,has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of spring

a tributary of Spring Creek

for the purpose of

irrigation of 3.2 acres and domestic use for one family

under Permit No. 14019 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the rights hereby confirmed dates from August 30, 1939

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.043 cubic foot per second, being 0.04 cfs for irrigation and 0.003 cfs for domestic

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the  $\,$  NW  $\,$ 1/4,  $\,$ 8 Section 21,  $\,$ 728S,  $\,$ 814W,  $\,$ 8 WM;  $\,$ 1,500 feet North and 80 feet East from W  $\,$ 1/4 Corner, Section 21.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

1.6 acres SE 1/4 NE 1/4

Section 20

Domestic and 1.6 acres SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 21

Township 28 South, Range 14 West, WM

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded at page 21715, Volume 16, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered January 22, 1969, approving Transfer Application P-99 and is issued to confirm a change in place of use approved by the same order.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
