CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

PETER B. and CORA D. CRANDALL

of Eagle Point, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of the waters of Little Butte Creek

a tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of Power

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 14, at page 498; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1872

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 24.4 cubic feet per second.

The point of diversion is located in the SW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 35, T35S, R1W, WM; 90 feet North and 1,150 feet East from SW Corner, Section 35.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Butte Creek or Daley Flouring Mill at Eagle Point, Oregon
NE 1/4 NE 1/4
Section 3
Township 36 South, Range 1 West, WM

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded at page 17191, Volume 14, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT canceled by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on July 17, 1978 and July 6, 1981.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
