CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That C. F. FOSS

of Grants Pass, RFD 1, State of Oregon 97726 has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Walker Creek

a tributary of Jump-Off-Joe Creek for the purpose of irrigation of 10 acres and domestic

under Permit No. 3176 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the rights hereby confirmed dates from November 18, 1916

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.23 cubic feet per second, being 0.13 cfs for irrigation and 0.10 cfs for domestic.

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 13, T35S, R6W, WM; 200 feet South and 1,665 feet East from NW Corner, Section 13.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Domestic and 10.0 acres SE 1/4 SE 1/4
Section 11
Township 35 South, Range 6 West, WM


This certificate is issued so as to correctly describe the location of the place of use and supersedes Certificate of Water Right recorded at page 1844, Volume 3, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
