CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, ThatGEORGE R. BOWEN, JR.,
MARION E. BOWEN

of PO Box 295, Wolf Creek, State of Oregon 97497, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of unnamed gulch and spring

a tributary of Grave Creek Watershed for the purpose of irrigation of 2.5 acres and domestic

under Permit No. 8859 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the rights hereby confirmed dates from December 21, 1928

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.08 cubic foot per second, being 0.03 cfs for irrigation and 0.05 cfs for domestic

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 20, T33S, R6W, WM; gulch - 400 feet South and 630 feet West; spring - 510 feet South and 670 feet West, both from N 1/4 Corner, Section 20.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Domestic and 2.5 acres NE 1/4 NW 1/4
Section 20
Township 33 South, Range 6 West, WM


This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded at page 9780, Volume 9, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT canceled by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on December 10, 1981, and also corrects the location of the point of diversion.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
