CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That RAYMOND E. and LILLIAN M. AMY

of 7414 SE 66th Avenue, Portland, State of Oregon 97206, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Murphy Creek and a spring

a tributary of Applegate River for the purpose of irrigation of 1.2 acres and domestic for one family

under Permit No. 23999 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 12, 1955

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.025 cubic foot per second; being 0.015 cfs from Murphy Creek for irrigation and 0.01 cfs from the spring for domestic use,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 36, T37S, R6W, WM; 780 feet North and 680 feet East from SW Corner, Section 36.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

domestic and 1.2 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 36
Township 37 South, Range 6 West, WM


This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded at page 27279, Volume 19, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on November 23, 1981, approving Transfer Application 4844.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
