## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

JOHN C. HORTON

**This Is to Certify, That**

of 225 Southshore Lane, Klamath Falls, State of Oregon 97601, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Sand Creek

a tributary of Williamson River for the purpose of irrigation of 80.0 acres and stock

under Permit No. 37716 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the rights hereby confirmed dates from December 21, 1974

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 2.02 cubic feet per second, being 2.0 cfs for irrigation and 0.02 cfs for stock

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 18, T31S, R8E, WM; 860 feet East from SW Corner, Section 18

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year provided further that during the irrigation season the water for stock shall be a part of that diverted from irrigation and shall not at any time exceed 2.0 cfs

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.


A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Stock and 40.0 acres SE 1/4 NE 1/4  
40.0 acres NE 1/4 SE 1/4  
Section 21  
Township 31 South, Range 8 East, WM

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
