## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That** MAX W. and GLADYS WINDER

of 1112 Fir Avenue, Tillamook, State of Oregon 97141, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of a spring

a tributary of Nestucca River for the purpose of domestic use at camp trailer site

under Permit No. 39331 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the rights hereby confirmed dates from August 5, 1974 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.005 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 30, T3S, R8W, WM; 420 feet North and 3,100 feet West from E 1/4 Corner, Section 30

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.


A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NW 1/4 SE 1/4  
Section 30  
Township 3 South, Range 8 West, WM

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
