ROY W. DAGGETT

of Box D, Joseph , State of Oregon 97846 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Wallowa River, Prairie Creek, and McCully Creek

a tributary of Grande Ronde River
irrigation of 68.4 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 38768 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the rights hereby confirmed dates from April 30, 1974

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.71 cubic feet per second, being 0.85 cfs from Wallowa River, 0.43 cfs from Prairie Creek, and 0.43 cfs from McCully Creek

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 5, T3S, R45E, WM; Wallowa River -- South 77 degrees, 20 minutes East, 624 feet from NW Corner, Section 5; SW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 26, T2S, R45E, WM; Prairie Creek -- North 63 degrees, 39 minutes West, 2,337 feet from S 1/4 Corner, Section 26; NE 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 19, T3S, R46E, WM; McCully Creek -- 2,300 feet East from NW *

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 1/2 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

* Corner, Section 19

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
