## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

## This is to Certify, That N. D. Brown

, has made proof State of Halfway to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of discharged from mines from Cornucopia Mines Company for the purpose of irrigation a tributary of Pine Creek of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters under Permit No. 3521 has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 12, 1917;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed

## 1.75 cubic feet per second.

The use hereunder for irrigation shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent in case of rotation.

A description of the lands irrigated under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where the water is put to beneficial Twenty-four (24) acres in the Northeast Quarter of the Southwest use), is as follows: Cuarter (NE-15W2) of Section Twenty-five (25), Township Seven (7) South, Range Forty-five (45) East, W. M.;) Thirty-eight and 2/10 (38.2) acres in the Northeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (NE2NW2), \Thirty-eight and 7/10 (38.7) acres in the Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (SE2NW2), Tairty-six and 5/10 (36.5) acres in the Northwest Cuarter of the Northeast (warter (NW4ME4)) and Forty (40) acres in the Southwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (SWANEA) of Section Eighteen (18), Township Eight (8) South, Range Forty-six (46) East of the Willamette Meridian, in Baker County, Oregon, being a total of 177.4 acres.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

Rights to the use of water for power purposes are limited to a period of forty years from the date of priority of the right, as herein set forth, subject to a preference right of renewal under the laws existing at the date of the expiration of the right for power purposes, as hereby confirmed and limited.
