## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That** PACIFIC CARBIDE and ALLOYS CO.

of PO Box 17008, Portland, State of Oregon 97217, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of two wells

a tributary of Columbia Slough for the purpose of industrial

under Permit No. G-7595 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 9, 1977

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.9 cubic foot per second, being 0.95 cfs from each well

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the well. The well is located in the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 as projected within J. Windle DLC, Section 5, T1N, R1E, WM; Well 3 - 1,204 feet South and 489 feet East, Well 2 - 1,444 feet South and 564 feet East both from NW Corner J. Windle DLC

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.


A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
