## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That**

DONALD L. and PATRICIA A. KEHR

of 303 Miller Avenue, Tillamook, State of Oregon 97141, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of South Fork Trask River

a tributary of Trask River for the purpose of irrigation of 0.5 acre, domestic use for one family and fire protection,

under Permit No. 41809 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the rights hereby confirmed dates from March 3, 1977

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.015 cubic foot per second, being 0.01 cfs for irrigation and 0.005 cfs for domestic use and fire protection

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 1 (NE 1/4 NE 1/4), Section 1, T2S, R8W, WM; 100 feet South and 875 feet West from the NE Corner, Section 1

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.


A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Domestic, fire protection and irrigation 0.5 acre Lot 1 (NE 1/4 NE 1/4)  
Section 1  
Township 2 South, Range 8 West, WM

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
