CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That DEPARTMENT OF FISH AND WILDLIFE

of PO Box 3503, Portland, State of Oregon 97208, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Three Rivers

a tributary of Nestucca River for the purpose of fish rearing

under Permit No. 42623 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the rights hereby confirmed dates from October 13, 1977

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 5.0 cubic feet per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 24, T4S, R10W, WM; 1,178 feet South and 744 feet West from NE Corner, Section 24.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to _____ of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:



NE 1/4 NE 1/4
Section 24
Township 4 South, Range 10 West, WM

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
