that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.25 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the $SE\ 1/4$ NE 1/4 as projected within A. Smith DLC 47, Section 17, T4S, R3W, WM; 850 North and 755 feet West from E 1/4 Corner, Section 17

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second

right is subject to the maintenance and use of adequate treatment facilities to remove the sediment before returning water to the stream,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

> SE 1/4 NE 1/4 as projected within A. Smith DLC 47 Section 17 Township 4 South, Range 3 West, WM

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
