## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That** THOMAS L. TUFFORD

of 17462 SE Walta Vista Drive, Milwaukie, State of Oregon 97222, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of unnamed stream

a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of irrigation of 0.75 acre

under Permit No. 41041 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the rights hereby confirmed dates from August 24, 1976

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 as projected within Rogers DLC 37, Section 13, T2S, R1E, WM; 120 feet North and 890 feet East from Westerly Corner, Rogers DLC 37

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:


0.75 acre SW 1/4 NE 1/4 as projected within Rogers DLC 37  
Section 13  
Township 2 South, Range 1 East, WM

Land upon which water used more explicitly described as Lot 5 Walta Vista Subdivision

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
