CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

JOHN D. HAFER

of Izee Route, Canyon City ,State of Oregon 97820 ,has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of unnamed spring and reservoir constructed under Permit R-6458

a tributary of Canyon Creek
domestic use for one family and irrigation of 0.4 acre

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 40447 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the rights hereby confirmed dates from April 30, 1975

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.015 cubic foot per second, being 0.005 cfs from spring for domestic and 0.01 cfs from spring and reservoir for irrigation

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the $\,$ SW $\,$ 1/4 $\,$ NW $\,$ 1/4, $\,$ Section $\,$ 24, $\,$ T14S, $\,$ R31 $\,$ E, $\,$ WM; $\,$ 850 feet North and $\,$ 320 feet East from $\,$ W $\,$ 1/4 $\,$ Corner, $\,$ Section $\,$ 24.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit R-6458

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Domestic and 0.4 acre SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 24 Township 14 South, Range 31 East, WM

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
