## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That** ARNO R. and BRIGITTE HINDEMITE

of 1255 Slate Creek Road, Wilderville, State of Oregon 97543, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Slate Creek

a tributary of Applegate River for the purpose of domestic use for two families and irrigation of 0.9 acre

under Permit No. 42427 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 2, 1977 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second, being 0.01 cfs for domestic and 0.01 cfs for irrigation

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 7, T37S, R7W, WM; 130 feet North and 370 feet East from SW Corner, Section 7.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 1/2 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:


0.2 acre SE 1/4 SE 1/4  
Section 12  
Township 37 South, Range 8 West, WM

In processing the application towards issuance of the permit, it appears that a clerical error was inadvertently made in limiting the duty of water to not exceed one-fortieth of one cfs per acre and 4 1/2 acre-feet per acre. In the issuance of this certificate, the duty of water has been reduced to one-eightieth cfs per acre and 4 1/2 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, in keeping with the customary policy and determination of this office of the proper maximum limits.

*The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described. and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board*
