5847 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in under Permit No. accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.123 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE_4 SE_4 as projected within Reed DLC 58, Section 5, T25S, R5W, WM; 820 feet South and 3,080 feet East from NW Corner, Reed DLC 58.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightiethof one cubic foot per second per acre,

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows: 4.2 acres SW_4 SE $_4$ as projected within Reed DLC 58

Township 25 South, Range 5 West, WM This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded at page 39353, Volume 31, State Record of Water Right Cer-

tificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered March 25, 1982, approving Transfer 4997 and correctly describes the place of use.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture

or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
