## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify,** That JOHN HAMLIN

of Box 138, Canyonville, State of Oregon 97417, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Canyon Creek

a tributary of South Umpqua River for the purpose of irrigation of 0.95 acre

under Permit No. 17456 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from January 2, 1947 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.015 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected within James G. Clark DLC 51, Section 27, T30S, R5W, WM; 110 feet South and 420 feet West from interior "L" Corner of DLC 51

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.95 acre SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  as projected within James G. Clark DLC 51  
Section 27  
Township 30 South, Range 5 West, WM


This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded at page 49002, Volume 42, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on March 25, 1982, approving Transfer Application 5002.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
