## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That**EARL STONEROD and EDWARD M. MURPHY,  
CHARLES H. and PATRICIA L. MAY

953 SE Main Street, Roseburg,  
of PO Box 143, Roseburg, State of Oregon 97470, has made  
proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of  
Champagne Creek

a tributary of South Umpqua River for the purpose of  
irrigation of 1.9 acres

under Permit No. 29244 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in  
accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from  
November 22, 1963

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes  
aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed  
0.024 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.  
The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , both as projected within  
La Point DLC 64, Section 6, T27S, R6W, WM; 660 feet South and 380 feet East;  
370 feet South and 710 feet East; 70 feet South and 1,220 feet East; 440 feet  
South and 2,020 feet East, all from NW Corner, DLC 64.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other  
right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second  
per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited  
to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated  
during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the right to  
use of water is limited to the period when the flow of the South Umpqua River  
is more than 60 cfs at its mouth;

and shall  
conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right  
is appurtenant, is as follows:


