CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That CLARK B. KNAPP

of 6950 De Celis Place, Van Nuys, State of California, has a right to the use of the waters of Applegate River

a tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of irrigation of 7.4 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 16, at page 523; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1902

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.143 cubic foot per second.

The point of diversion is located in the NW 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 19, T37S, R5W, WM; Murphy Ditch - South 20 degrees East, 780 feet from N 1/4 Corner, Section 19.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

7.4 acres NW 1/4 SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 24 Township 37 South, Range 6 West, WM

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded at page 32860, Volume 24, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on April 19, 1982, approving Transfer Application 4849.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
