CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

of Umapine Road, Milton-Freewater, State of Oregon 97881, has a right to the use of the waters of Goodman Spring Branch

a tributary of Walla Walla River for the purpose of irrigation of 18.1 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 1, at page 466; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from --- that the rights for the lands herein described and of E.C. Kralman for 7 acres in NW 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 29, T6N, R35E, WM,\* that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.16 cubic foot per second, if available at the original point of diversion; SE 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 29, T6N, R35E, WM; 400 feet North and 100 feet West from E 1/4 Corner, Section 29.

The point of diversion is located in the SE 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 29, T6N, R35E, WM; 580 feet North and 670 feet West from E 1/4 Corner, Section 29.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

\* are coordinate in time and equal in right and constitute the second right to the waters of said Goodman Spring Branch.

18.1 acres W 1/2 SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 29 Township 6 North, Range 35 East, WM

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered March 8, 1967 and together with certificate of water right recorded at page 35092, Volume 27, State Record of Water Right Certificates, supersedes certificate of water right recorded at page 3827, Volume 5, State Record of Water Right Certificates

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
