CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That CARL E. YODER

of Route 1, Sheridan, State of Oregon 97378, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of South Yamhill River

a tributary of Yamhill River for the purpose of irrigation of 7.3 acres

under Permit No. 22689 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from October 5, 1953 for 0.064 cubic foot per second and December 14, 1953 for 0.028 cfs that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.092 cfs

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 as projected within Eads DLC 38, Section 34, T5S, R6W, WM

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

7.3 acres NE 1/4 SW 1/4 as projected within Eads DLC 38
Section 34
Township 5 South, Range 6 West, WM


This certificate is issued to supersede Certificate of Water Right recorded at page 43622, Volume 35 State Record of Water Right Certificates, so as to correctly describe the place of use.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
