## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That** CLINTON J. and MAY CODY

of 17588 South Holly Lane, Oregon City, State of Oregon 97045, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of unnamed spring creek

a tributary of Abernathy Creek for the purpose of irrigation of 1.6 acres and stock

under Permit No. 42004 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the rights hereby confirmed dates from September 20, 1977

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.025 cubic foot per second, being 0.02 cfs for irrigation and 0.005 cfs for stock

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 as projected within Fisher DLC 44, Section 33, T2S, R2E, WM; 760 feet North and 2,080 feet West from SE Corner, Fisher DLC 44

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.


A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Stock and 1.6 acres NE 1/4 SW 1/4 as projected within Fisher DLC 44  
Section 33  
Township 2 South, Range 2 East, WM

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
