## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That**

VERNON E. and BILLIE JANE JONES

of 28B North Reuben Road, Glendale, State of Oregon 97442, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Cow Creek

a tributary of South Umpqua River for the purpose of stock use and irrigation of 9.6 acres

under Permit No. 35639 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from October 8, 1970: 0.005 cubic foot per second for stock and 0.02 cfs for\* that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.145 cfs being 0.005 cfs for stock use and 0.14 cfs for irrigation

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 36, T32S, R7W, WM; 220 feet North and 150 feet West from SE Corner, Section 36

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-seventieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 1/2 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

\* irrigation; January 29, 1971: 0.12 cfs for irrigation



In processing the application towards issuance of the permit, it appears that a clerical error was inadvertently made in limiting the duty of water to not exceed one-eightieth of 1 cfs per acre and 2 1/2 acre-feet per acre. In the issuance of this certificate, the duty of water has been raised to one-seventieth cfs per acre and 3 1/2 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, in keeping with the customary policy and determination of this office of the proper maximum limits.

*The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described. and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board*
