CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That CHARLES W. and EDNA M. GLADE

of 270 Hardcash Lane, Camas Valley, State of Oregon 97416, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Mill Creek and spring

a tributary of Middle Fork Coquille River for the purpose of irrigation of 4.8 acres

under Permit No. 40884 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the rights hereby confirmed dates from July 15, 1976

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.06 cubic foot per second, being 0.05 cfs from Mill Creek and 0.01 cfs from the spring

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 1 (NE 1/4 NE 1/4), Section 36, T29S, R9W, WM; Lot 4 (NW 1/4 NW 1/4), Section 31, T29S, R8W, WM; Mill Creek - 210 feet North and 50 feet West; Spring - 700 feet North and 200 feet East both from SE Corner, Lot 1 (NE 1/4 NE 1/4), Section 36

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:


1.8 acres Lot 1 (NE 1/4 NE 1/4)
Section 36
Township 29 South, Range 9 West, WM

3.0 acres Lot 4 (NW 1/4 NW 1/4)
Section 31
Township 29 South, Range 8 West, 31

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
