of Route 2, Box 82B, Willamina ,State of Oregon 97396 ,has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Willamina Creek

a tributary of South Yamhill River
irrigation of 1.5 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 26028 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the rights hereby confirmed dates from March 4, 1959

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.013 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the $SW\ 1/4\ SE\ 1/4$, as projected within Burford DLC 44, Section 24, T5S, R7W, WM; 1,580 feet South and 1,720 feet West from the E 1/4 Corner, Section 24

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

1.5 acres SW 1/4 SE 1/4 as projected within Burford DLC 44
Section 24

Township 5 South, Range 7 West, WM

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered January 26, 1977 and together with Certificate of Water Right recorded at page 45018, Volume 37, State Record of Water Right Certificates, supersedes Certificate 28293.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
