CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That PAUL J. DOMBY

of Route 2, Box 27, Huntington , State of Oregon 97907 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Snake River

a tributary of Columbia River irrigation of 134.3 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 29379 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from January 23, 1964

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 3.36 cubic feet per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW4 NE4, Section 16, T15S, R46E, WM; 610 feet south and 1,780 feet east from SE Corner, NW4 NW4, Section 16.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

22.8 acres SW4 NW4 Section 16

21.1 acres SE4 NE4 20.0 acres NE4 NW4

19.0 acres NE4 NE4 39.4 acres NW4 NE4

12.0 acres Lot 1 (NW4 NW4)

Section 17 Township 15 South, Range 46 East, WM

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded at page 35364, Volume 27, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT canceled by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on June 8, 1982.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
