**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That** OWYHEE DITCH COMPANY

of PO Box 280, Ontario, State of Oregon 97914, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Owyhee River and Owyhee Reservoir constructed under Permits R-599 and R-1764

a tributary of Snake River for the purpose of irrigation of 5.4 acres

under Permit No. 40841 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the rights hereby confirmed dates from August 11, 1976

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.09 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 2 (SW 1/4 NW 1/4), Section 18, T21S, R46E, WM; 1,900 feet South and 700 feet East from the NW Corner, Section 18, Owyhee Reservoir - NW 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 20, T22S, R45E, WM.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-sixtieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permits R-599 and R-1764

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

5.4 acres NW 1/4 NE 1/4  
Section 31  
Township 18 South, Range 47 East, WM


This certificate is issued to correctly describe the point of diversion and supersedes Certificate of Water Right recorded at page 48629, Volume 42, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
