CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, ThatW.S. EDWARDS, MRS. EMMA C. KRALMAN
and L.E. NOLAN

of Freewater _____, State of Oregon _____, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of springs and seepage water from Hudson Bay Ditch

a tributary of Goodman Spring Branch _____ for the purpose of irrigation of 26.4 acres

under Permit No. 5309 _____ and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 19, 1921 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.34 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW 1/4, Section 28, T6N, R35E, WM

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

13.0 acres NW 1/4 NE 1/4
12.0 acres N 1/2 SW 1/4 NE 1/4
1.4 acres SE 1/4 NE 1/4
Section 29
Township 6 North, Range 35 East, WM


This certificate is issued to correct the location of the place of use of water and supersedes certificate of water right recorded at page 5568, Volume 6, State Record of Water Right Certificates

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
