## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT


**This Is to Certify, That**RACHAEL MCCAFFERY,  
FRANK W. MCCAFFERY and ROBERT SMITHof Sisters, State of Oregon 97759, has  
a right to the use of the waters of Squaw Creeka tributary of Deschutes River for the purpose of  
irrigation of 14.0 acres and domestic useand that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for  
Deschutes County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of  
the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 1, at page 120; that the priority of the right  
thereby confirmed dates from 1885that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an  
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.29 cubic foot  
per second

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as

Township 15 South, Range 10 East, WMThis certificate supersedes Certificate of Water Right recorded at page 45030,  
Volume 37, State Record of Water Right Certificates, to describe the right as  
corrected by a decree and order of the Circuit Court for Deschutes County,  
entered April 16, 1968.The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of  
the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to  
forfeiture or abandonment.And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.  
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein  
described.
