CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, *That* ESTATE OF R.J. STOCKDALE

of Mt. Vernon, State of Oregon, has
a right to the use of the waters of John Day River

a tributary of _____ for the purpose of
irrigation of 54.3 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Grant County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 15, at page 461; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1866

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one-fortieth cubic foot per second per acre irrigated from April 1 to September 30; further limited to one acre-foot per acre per calendar month to July 1 and three-fourths acre-foot per acre thereafter; total five acre-feet per acre for season

The point of diversion is located in the NW 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 26, T13S, R30E, WM; Fry-Ingle Ditch - 1,200 feet South and 1,175 feet East from N 1/4 Corner, Section 26

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

37.7 acres NW 1/4 NW 1/4
Section 27
16.6 acres NE 1/4 NE 1/4
Section 28
Township 13 South, Range 30 East, WM


This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded at page 25875, Volume 17, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on September 12, 1977, approving Transfer Application 3595

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
