CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That VOENEY ODEN

of RFD 1, Rogue River, State of Oregon 97537, has
a right to the use of the waters of
Evans Creek

a tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of
domestic, stock, and irrigation of 3.0 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
JACKSON County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 16, at page 523; that the priority of the right
thereby confirmed dates from 1902,

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.05 cubic foot
per second.

The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 11, T35S, R4W, WM.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as
follows:

3.0 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 15
Township 35 South, Range 4 West, WM


This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the
prior certificate recorded at page 32782, Volume 24, State Record of Water Right
Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources
Director entered on July 2, 1982, approving Transfer Application 5026.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the
water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture
or abandonment.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein
described.
