CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That LYLE E. HAYDEN in the name of
U.S. FOREST SERVICE

of PO Box 594, Grants Pass, State of Oregon 97526, has made
proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of
a spring

a tributary of _____ for the purpose of
group domestic use for nine families

under Permit No. 29659 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in
accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from
May 7, 1964

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes
aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed
0.005 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.
The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 14, T37S, R5E, WM; North 38
degrees 39 minutes East, 1,885 feet from the SW Corner, Section 14.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other
right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second
per acre,

and shall
conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right
is appurtenant, is as follows:

Lot 2 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$)
Section 14
Township 37 South, Range 5 East, WM


This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the
prior certificate recorded at page 34999, Volume 27, State Record of Water Right
Certificates, NOT canceled by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources
Director entered on July 29, 1982.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the
water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture
or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place
of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the
Water Policy Review Board.
